

Admission Policy

Calvary Chapel Academy (CCA) is open to families of K-8 students interested in obtaining a Christian education. Candidates for admission are considered on their academic record, discipline record, standardized test scores, enthusiasm for learning and parental support of the vision and mission of CCA.

All students must have a desire to attend Calvary Chapel Academy. They should also agree to be courteous and respectful to their peers, staff, faculty and others. CCA reserves the right to select students and families based on their worldview, lifestyle choices, academic performance and personal qualifications, including the willingness to cooperate with the Administration and abide by the school policies.

To be considered for admission to Calvary Chapel Academy students and their parents must finalize the application paperwork, complete a placement exam, and sit for a family interview with the school principal. As a school that seeks to assist parents in training up their children in a Bible-based, Christian worldview, it is expected that at least one parent be a practicing, born-again Christian.

If the student can be properly placed and the requirements are met, parents will be notified by letter of their child's acceptance. Parents and students are expected to follow the guidelines and expectations elaborated on in our Parent/Student Handbook. Our students should agree to "...walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory." 1 Thessalonians 2:12.
