

Supply List - Fifth Grade

REQUIRED – Good quality supplies will assure that they last through the year and will limit frustrations. ^(C) Label all items with the student's name.

- Bible (New King James version NKJV)
- Colored pencils (recommend Crayola)
- Markers (recommend Crayola)
- Clear plastic 12" ruler
- Scissors (good quality, such as Fiskars)
- Glue sticks (3)
- Pencils: a <u>large</u> supply, sharpened. *No mechanical pencils, please!!*
- Pens: blue or black
- Pencil-top erasers
- Block erasers, <u>at least</u> 2 (one good brand is Pentel)
- Composition notebooks: 5th grade 2 wide ruled; 6th grade one wide ruled, one graph paper; 8th grade 1 wide or college ruled
- Index cards with box or container for storage
- 2" binder with 5 dividers
- Pockets folders (5 or 6)
- Wide rule paper, loose leaf or spiral bound
- Pencil bag
- Art smock
